Welcome to the flea market of cycling boardgames! The games offered in this jumble are cheap for a reason: All game boards and boxes unfortunately are broken, they and the figurines are scattered all over the place. There are some quite old and rare games to be discovered, though. Will you manage to join together the largest amount of boards, boxes and figurines – and found a prestigious cycling boardgames collection?

The **Cycling Boardgames Collectors Game** is played according to the usual rules of the well known matching card games, apart from the following exceptions:

- The cards don't show identical pictures, but different halves of boards or boxes (or parts of figurine sets). If you turned over two cards with parts fitting together, you keep this "pair" of a board, box or figurines.
- If in doubt whether it's the same game or not, please check the game names written on each card.
- To experienced collectors the **advanced scoring rules** are recommended:







Each "pair" that you collected, scores 1 point – for two cards with the same game name.


If you collected **two "pairs" of the same game**, this scores 1 extra point – i.e. 3 points for four cards with the same game name.

If you're a lucky person and collected **all three "pairs" of the same game** (there are only six such sets in this game), this scores 3 extra points – i.e. 6 points for six cards with the same game name.


Winner of the game is the collector having scored the most points.
